

Camp Io-Dis-E-Ca  
Family Campground Policies

1. **Alcohol**

Alcohol is allowed. It may only be consumed your campsite. Alcohol is not to leave your campsite area. **Drunkenness will not be tolerated and is grounds for dismissal from camp property.**

2. **Vehicles and Parking**

Campsites are allowed to have 2 vehicles. Additional vehicles must be parked in the parking area near the bathrooms. Vehicles may not be parked at other or open campsites. Please have your guests park in the parking area near the bathrooms if you already have 2 vehicles at your site.

3. **Campsite Appearance**

a. Campsites must remain clean and organized. Outside of small yard and holiday decorations, temporary games, and items specific to camping, campsite lawns and pads are to remain clean and open.

b. Campers are allowed 1 boat to have at their campsite. Additional boats may be stored at the main camp for \$25/month or you may find another location to store your boat.

c. Campsite lawns and pads are not to be altered in any way. Campers may add temporary decorations. All campers must be able to move their site in case of emergency or evacuation and campsites must reflect the ability to do so.

d. Campers may be subject to move their site after two weeks in one location.

4. **Payments**

a. Payments for your stay are due upon arrival. Please place payments in the slot on the door where the registration forms are located. Credit card payments are accepted at the Main Camp.

b. Payments for monthly-rate guests are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month OR a predetermined date scheduled with the Camp Site Manager.

5. **Firewood & Fires**

a. Firewood is for sale alongside the shop building. Bundles of firewood are \$5 each or buy two and get one free. Payment, which may be placed in the payment door slot, is due prior to taking any firewood.

b. Though brush, sticks, and twigs may be gathered from the woods, guests may not cut lumber from the Camp's woods.

c. Fires are only permitted at existing fire rings and shall not be unattended. Fire ring locations will not be moved.

6. **Sewage Dump**

Monthly-rate campers may dump their sewage down the drain between the parking area and the bathrooms at no additional cost. All other guests must pay a \$5 fee to dump.

7. **Shop Access**

The Shop and its contents, in addition to the Camp's machinery are to be considered off-limits. Guests will not enter the shop without the permission and supervision of Camp staff. Guests will not operate machinery without the permission and direction of the Camp Site Manager.

8. **Storage**

Storage is available for your boat or camper for \$25/month. Please arrange storage and storage location with the Camp Site Manager.

9. **Garbage**

There is a dumpster located on the west end of the parking area for your use.

10. **Pets**

Pets are allowed. They are to be kept on a leash at all times and are to be cleaned up after. Pet owners are responsible for their pet's incidents or damage.

11. **Smoking**

Smoking is allowed. It is only permitted at your campsite or vehicle. Smoking is not allowed near the Camp buildings. Any use of Illegal substances will result in law enforcement and permanent dismissal from the campground.

12. **Supervision**

Children are to have adult supervision at all times.

13. **Clothes**

Guests will be properly clothed including shirt. It is recommended that shoes be worn at all times but is required upon leaving your campsite.

14. **Damage**

Damage due to negligent behavior will be billed to the responsible party at the cost of the repair plus 20%.

15. **Water Hookups**

Please be prepared to share water hookups. Do not use water hookups from another site.

16. **Hunting & Firearms**

There is no hunting. Firearms are not allowed on camp property.

17. **Conduct and Dismissal**

Guests will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times. Disorderly conduct, as well as consistent disregard for the above policies is grounds for dismissal and forfeiture of paid fees.
