

**Additional 2020 COVID-19
Family Campground Guidelines**
As of May 15, 2020

Prerequisites: 1) Campsites available by reservation only, no walk-ins; 2) If you or a member of your camping group or household have experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days, please stay home; 3) Only campers with functioning, self-contained bathrooms are allowed.

Guest Health: To protect all other visitors, we ask that if you have experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days, please stay home. These symptoms include, but are not limited to, fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, sore throat, and loss of taste/smell. Visit [CDC.gov](https://www.cdc.gov) for more information. If you experience any of these symptoms while here or within the next week, please notify camp staff immediately, leave the campground, and notify your healthcare provider immediately.

Disinfecting: Guests are encouraged to frequently wash hands and wear masks when appropriate.

Duration of Stay: Recreational camping guests are limited to an uninterrupted two week stay.

Guests: Only those camping overnight are allowed on at the camp. No visitors are allowed.

Occupancy Limits: Campsites will be limited to one household, with 6 people or less.

Campsite Usage: The campground will be operating at a restricted capacity. Several sites are closed to aid in social distancing measures. Blocked off sites are closed.

Dump Station: The dump station is closed until further notice. Those requiring a dump site will be directed to the BP in Shueyville.

Shower House: The shower houses and public restrooms are closed until further notice. All campers must have functioning, self-contained bathrooms.

Campfires: Campfires will consist of residents of the campsite only. No guests.

Pets: Pets are to be kept on a leash at all times.

Activities: Any and all activities in the campground will be done with your group only. Keep appropriate distance between your group and others while enjoying the campground and the surrounding area.
