

Day Camp - Camper & Parent Policy Guidelines

Any camper who is ill or showing any symptoms of COVID-19 must not come to Camp. If within the 14 days prior to attending camp, campers who have they themselves had symptoms or diagnosis of COVID-19, or have been exposed to symptoms of COVID-19 or someone diagnosed, will require a doctor's evaluation before coming to camp.

Campers must not have traveled by air in the 14 days prior to camp.

- **General**

- Any camper who becomes ill will be quarantined in a high-comfort room until they can be picked up.
- We will try to keep cabin groups to 6 campers each by default. Cabin groups will not have more than 8 campers.
- Each cabin group will have 2 counselors.
- Campers will only interact with their immediate cabin group and counselors. Cabin groups will not do activities with other cabin groups. Social distancing will be strictly practiced in relation to other cabin groups.
- All Campers will have washable cloth face covers with them for use when physical distancing is difficult. They will not be worn by default. Face coverings may be challenging for campers (especially younger campers) to wear in all-day settings such as camp.
- Each cabin group will have their own water cooler station to refill their own water bottles.
- All campers must have a backpack.
- All campers must have a water bottle.
- If a camper cannot attend, due to any reason, illness or otherwise, please inform the camp staff by emailing office@iodiseca.org.

- **Pre Camp**

- Parents will complete the Pre-Camp Health Screening and turn it in on Day 1 of camp and coordinate with full-time staff as necessary.
- Campers may not bring toys, stuffed animals, blankets, books, devices, games, or any other extra recreational/leisure items to camp. We will only be using camp activity items that can be cleaned and sanitized easily.

- **Drop-Off**

- On-site drop-off will take place in the parking lot. Campers who have already arrived will play at the Gazebo area with their cabin group.
- Campers will stay in their car until a staff member comes to check them in. All parent/guardians dropping campers off must wait to leave until after their camper's temperature is taken and an OK is given from the Day Camp Manager.

- **Transportation**

- Face Masks must be worn on the van to and from camp.

- Temperature Checks will be done before the parent leaves. Any camper with a 100.4 degree temperature or higher cannot participate.
- **Day 1**
 - There will be an all-camp orientation to introduce campers to important rules for the week, especially with regards to practicing social distancing and hygiene.
 - Campers will be shown their assigned bathrooms for restrooms and washing hands.
 - Campers will be taught how to wash their hands.
 - Teach and reinforce [handwashing](#) with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and increase monitoring to ensure adherence among campers and staff. If soap and water are not readily available, hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol can be used (for staff and older children who can safely use hand sanitizer).
- **Each Day**
 - Campers will have their temperature taken during each drop off and complete a daily health examination. Any camper with a 100.4 degree temperature or higher cannot participate.
 - Campers will eat with their cabin group. Cabin groups will be seated at least 6 feet away from another group.
 - Campers will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before each activity.
 - All campers will have a locker for the week to store their personal items.
- **Pick-Up**
 - Parent/Guardian picking up camper(s) will wait in the vehicle until greeted by the Day Camp Manager. They Day Camp Manager will bring the camper(s) to the vehicle for checkout.
- **Post-Camp**
 - If a camper experience symptoms or is diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the last day of their camp experience, please contact Camp Io-Dis-E-Ca so that it can be reported and documented. Additionally, campers in the cabin group and their families will be contacted to be alert for any symptoms and to report it as well.
