

COVID-19 User Group Policy Guidelines (03/08/2021)

- **General**

- Current default maximum overnight group size allowed is 84 (41 in Alpha Lodge, 43 Omega), which can be expanded to 96 upon request (12 beds in the basement of Omega.) This is based on the number of bottom beds available.
- Group is required to recommend anyone feeling ill to stay home from the event.
- Group is required to screen guests' temperatures upon arrival.
 - This is the responsibility of the group.
 - The group is allowed to use Camp's non-contact thermometers.
 - Any guest with a 100.4 degree temperature or higher cannot participate and must be sent home.
 - Any guest with symptoms of COVID-19, either upon arrival or developed throughout the event, cannot participate and must be sent home.
- Johnson County Mask/Face Covering Mandate (through March 26, 2021)
 - Requires every person in Johnson County to wear a face covering/mask when in public settings indoors and outdoors when it is not possible to keep 6 feet away from others.
- Social distancing is to be maintained.
 - Guests to stay 6 feet apart as often as possible.
 - Wearing a mask as often as possible is encouraged.
 - In settings where social distancing cannot be maintained, participants are required to wear a mask. This may include:
 - Seating for a presentation.
 - Doing an activity.
- Tables should be spread out at least 6 feet apart in dining hall/activity hall.
- Hospitality stations are available throughout both lodges (at least in every room.) These stations include masks, hand-sanitizer, and tissues.
