Welcome to Camp Iodiseca

This guide is to help you prepare for an exciting week at Camp Iodiseca! Please review the contents of this guide to ensure your camper's experience will be smooth from arrival to departure.

Registration Forms

All camper registration forms must be completed online. Your Camper Profile and waiver were required to complete registration.

The Camper Experience Survey and Medical Information Sheet must be completed one week prior to arriving at camp. These can be found by logging into your account on our website.

An Immunization Record is only required for campers who reside outside of Iowa. This should be emailed to office@iodiseca.org to be uploaded to your camper's profile.

Last Day

Be sure to check the lost and found and stop by the canteen to request your camper's canteen balance refund before leaving camp.

Canteen (The Camp Store)

Campers may purchase food & drink (within limits) every time the canteen is open while at camp. T-shirts, hats, water bottles, and other souvenir items are also available. We suggest \$15 for a week of Day Camp. Be sure to talk with your camper about how to use this privilege.

Check-in

At drop-off on Monday, all remaining registration balances are due. You can also add funds to your camper's canteen account. We accept cash, checks, and most cards. All medications and health concerns should also be discussed with camp staff.

The name of the individual who will be picking up the camper must be provided each day at check-in. If your plans change during the day, please call the camp office at 319-848-4187. **We will not release your camper to an unauthorized individual.**

Parent Transportation

Drop-Off 7:45-8:15am

Pick-up 4:30-5:00pm

As you enter the camp, continue straight until you reach the parking lot and the lodges. Daily check-in is at the outdoor Gazebo just outside of Alpha Lodge (orange building).



What to Bring:

- Swimsuit (NO BIKINIS)
- Pool Towel
- Refillable water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellant
- Hat/Visor
- Sunglasses
- Closed toe shoes
- Camera (disposable / screen free)
- Bible
- Jeans for horse riding

Do not bring – These items will be stored in the office if brought to camp.

- Ø Food/drink (gum, candy, snacks, etc)
- Ø Music players, iPod, radio or headphones
- Ø Cell phones
- Ø Electronic games
- Ø Digital cameras with display screens
- Ø Items of real, intrinsic or sentimental value
- Ø Jewelry
- Ø Items that could cause injury – knives, sharp objects, fireworks, etc.
- Ø Alcohol, tobacco, and other controlled substances.

Your driver will collect your registration balance payment (cash or check), all medications, including over-the-counters, and specific medical instructions. These will all be given to the Program Director or Camp Director upon arrival at camp. Please call the office to make a credit card payment.

Please discuss Camp Bus expectations with your camper prior to the first day of drop off.
